

Financial Assistance Policy

Plain Language Summary - Miami County Medical Center



All patients are expected to contribute to the cost of their care in accordance with their ability, but Miami County Medical Center (MCMC) recognizes unplanned medical expenses may have patients concerned about their ability to pay for those services. In order to be considered for assistance, you need to complete an application.

If you are interested in learning more about financial assistance for medical services at MCMC you may obtain an application and instructions in several ways (*see below*). Patients whose household income is up to 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (based on family size) may be eligible for assistance. Patients who qualify for financial assistance will not be asked to pay more than MCMC's amount generally billed (AGB) to individuals with insurance for emergency or medically necessary services.
